Prior to her role at CIPF, she held senior positions with Nesbitt Thomson, the Investment Dealers Association of Canada (predecessor to the Investment Industry Regulatory Organization of Canada) as head of its member regulation department, and Deloitte Touche. Rozanne recently served on the Board of the Canadian Securities Institute Research Foundation and the FCJ Refugee Centre. She holds a Master of Business Administration from the Harvard Business School and a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Waterloo. She holds the CPA, CA designation and became a Fellow (FCPA, FCA) in 2000. Rozanne also holds the Chartered Financial Analyst designation and earned the ICD.D designation from the Institute of Corporate Directors.
